

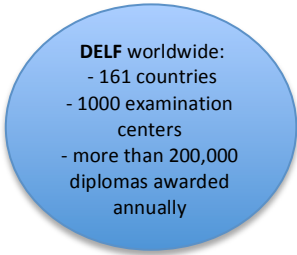
DELFLScolaire - A First in Northern Canada!

YCS students who are enrolled in all Grade 12 French programs will have the opportunity to access the DELF, an international diploma awarded by the Ministry of Education in France!

Why do it?

- Receive international recognition of your French language competency
- Enhance your resumé with a lifelong diploma
- Facilitate your entrance to University
- Help you find employment
- Certify your ability to use French in real-life based situations



What is the DELF?

The DELF is an official diploma awarded by the French Ministry of Education in France to certify the competency of candidates outside of France in the French language.

How are these diplomas organized?

The National Commission of the DELF provides a **harmonized system based on the Council of Europe's European standard.**

The DELF scolaire comprises **4 independent diplomas** corresponding to the first four levels of the Council of Europe's *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* (CEFR):



DELF scolaire	CEFR	User
DELF scolaire B2	B2	independent
DELF scolaire B1	B1	
DELF scolaire A2	A2	basic
DELF scolaire A1	A1	

Each examination comprises sections testing the four skills: oral production & reception and written production & reception. To obtain a diploma, it is necessary to pass (50 points out of 100). The examinations are structured in the same way as the adult versions, but the themes used are chosen to suit pre adolescent and adolescent candidates.

What are the conditions for sitting the examinations?

- The teacher will decide on the level the student will take
- French Immersion students must have completed or be enrolled in **FLA30**
- Core French students must have completed or be enrolled in **FR30**
- YCS will cover the cost of the exam. A \$60 deposit, refundable upon presentation for the exam, is required.
- To be successful at B2 level, students should take as many courses as possible in French

DELF Scolaire B2 – Monday, April 16, 2012 (10:00 am)

DELF Scolaire B1 – Tuesday, April 17, 2012 (10:00 am)

DELF Scolaire A2 – Wednesday, April 18, 2012 (10:00 am)

DELF Scolaire A1 – Thursday, April 19, 2012 (10:00 am)

Registration will take place between February 20 and March 1, 2012 in class with teachers
